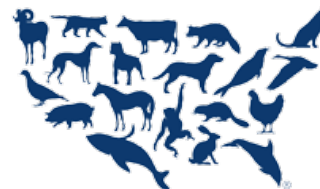
- Background on animal fighting and illegal animal abuse laws and investigations in NE
