The DEA Omaha Division and Omaha Police Department's Narcotics Unit present a free training seminar for street-level law enforcement officers.

Prescription drugs, including opioids, sedatives and stimulants, are the second most commonly abused drugs in the United States behind marijuana.

- Learn the roles and responsibilities of the DEA's Diversion Control Division.
- Learn about the most commonly diverted prescription drugs and how to identify them.
  - Learn how to conduct street level interdiction and what questions to ask suspects.
- Learn what to observe when responding to calls at pharmacies and how to investigate fraudulent or forged prescription cases.
- Hear from a local medical examiner on evidence gathering at drug overdose crime scene.
  - Case Study: Review lessons learned with OPD detectives on local fentanyl case.

Officers will also learn the correlation between prescription opioids and heroin, what efforts are being made to combat the opioid problem in the community and how their investigations contribute to the successful prosecutions of drug diverters.
