



NRA's Law Enforcement Precision Rifle

The Grand Island Police Dept. will be hosting Venger Tactical whom will be instructing the **NRA Law Enforcement Precision Rifle Certification**.

We will focus on the following:

- Marksmanship
- Handling techniques
- Safety
- Optical sights
- Zeroing, reading and setting turrets
- Ballistics
- Weather and other effects
- Data Books and Cards
- Range estimation
- Reduced Light
- Use of cover and concealment
- Moving targets
- Rifle maintenance
- Shooting various drills

Requirements:

- Precision rifle of .223 Rem to 300 Win. with Bi-Pod. Rifle must be able to shoot 1 MOA minimum at 100 yards.
- Precision rifle scope with adjustable turrets. No hunting scopes.
- 500 rounds precision rifle rounds
- 50 rounds of practice handgun ammunition
- Pass a written exam
- Pass a shooting qualification. 100% is required. The student will have two chances to qualify. If a student fails they will not receive certification.
- Pass a Proficiency Assessment. This is done throughout the week.

After completing the class, written test, and qualifications we will have a 1000 yard challenge the last day. This is not instructed. The student will use what they have learned throughout the week and the student has 5 rounds to complete the challenge (this is for fun only).

Cost is \$500.00 per student
August 20th through 24th 2018

The course will be in Grand Island, and Hastings Army National Guard Ranges. You will need to make lodging arrangements.
