**RE: Law Enforcement Certification Suspensions**

In the first quarter of 2011, the following suspensions of Nebraska Law Enforcement Certifications have taken place pursuant to Nebraska Administrative Code (NAC) Title 79, Chapter 4.

Action by the Police Standards Advisory Council on February 16, 2011:

**Deputy Mark W. Bottom** of the **Perkins County Sheriff's Office** for failure to qualify with his sidearm as required by NAC Title 79, Chapter 11 in 2010 and not being granted a waiver from the Council.

**Deputy Dale M. Johnson** of the **Washington County Sheriff's Office** for failure to qualify with his sidearm as required by NAC Title 79, Chapter 11 in 2010 and not being granted a waiver from the Council.

**Officer Christopher D. Parent** of the **Bellevue Police Department** for failure to qualify with his sidearm as required by NAC Title 79, Chapter 11 in 2010 and not being granted a waiver from the Council.

Action by the Director taken on March 15, 2011:

**Reserve Deputy Michael E. Sanne** of the **Plainview Police Department** for failure to meet standards to maintain active status by not applying for full certification training.
